

Find the missing place value from a 5-digit number

Grade 5 Addition Worksheet

Example: $58,467 = 50,000 + 8,000 + 400 + 60 + 7$

Find the missing numbers:

- 1) $70000 + 7000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 1 = 77,901$
- 2) $40000 + 2000 + 700 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 1 = 42,721$
- 3) $6000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 20 + 4 = 6,824$
- 4) $70000 + 3000 + 200 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 73,203$
- 5) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 5000 + 900 + 20 + 1 = 45,921$
- 6) $50000 + 3000 + 600 + 40 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 53,645$
- 7) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 1000 + 300 + 90 + 6 = 71,396$
- 8) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 2000 + 100 + 6 = 92,106$
- 9) $3000 + 200 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 9 = 3,269$
- 10) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 4000 + 100 + 8 = 64,108$

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Example: $58,467 = 50,000 + 8,000 + 400 + 60 + 7$

Find the missing numbers:

1) $70000 + 7000 + \underline{900} + 1 = 77,901$

2) $40000 + 2000 + 700 + \underline{20} + 1 = 42,721$

3) $6000 + \underline{800} + 20 + 4 = 6,824$

4) $70000 + 3000 + 200 + \underline{3} = 73,203$

5) $\underline{40,000} + 5000 + 900 + 20 + 1 = 45,921$

6) $50000 + 3000 + 600 + 40 + \underline{5} = 53,645$

7) $\underline{70,000} + 1000 + 300 + 90 + 6 = 71,396$

8) $\underline{90,000} + 2000 + 100 + 6 = 92,106$

9) $3000 + 200 + \underline{60} + 9 = 3,269$

10) $\underline{60,000} + 4000 + 100 + 8 = 64,108$
