

Find the missing place value from a 6-digit number

Grade 5 Addition Worksheet

Example: $182,681 = 100,000 + 80,000 + 2,000 + 600 + 80 + 1$

Find the missing numbers:

1) $500,000 + 6,000 + 500 + 90 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 506,595$

2) $900,000 + 30,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 400 + 2 = 932,402$

3) $200,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 70 + 3 = 202,073$

4) $400,000 + 60,000 + 7,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 4 = 467,404$

5) $200,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 600 + 9 = 207,609$

6) $100,000 + 50,000 + 1,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 151,070$

7) $600,000 + 90,000 + 700 + 20 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 690,726$

8) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 80,000 + 2,000 + 800 + 10 = 382,810$

9) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 20,000 + 200 + 20 + 2 = 720,222$

10) $700,000 + 50,000 + 3,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 753,003$

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$$5) \ 200000 + \underline{7,000} + 600 + 9 = 207,609$$

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$$7) \ 600000 + 90000 + 700 + 20 + \underline{6} = 690,726$$

$$8) \ \underline{300,000} + 80000 + 2000 + 800 + 10 = 382,810$$

$$9) \ \underline{700,000} + 20000 + 200 + 20 + 2 = 720,222$$

$$10) \ 700000 + 50000 + 3000 + \underline{3} = 753,003$$
