

Find the missing place value from a 6-digit number

Grade 5 Addition Worksheet

Example: $124,742 = 100,000 + 20,000 + 4,000 + 700 + 40 + 2$

Find the missing numbers:

1) $200000 + 90000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 4 = 298,004$

2) $500000 + 50000 + 100 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 550,110$

3) $400000 + 8000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 90 = 408,990$

4) $500000 + 30000 + 9000 + 900 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 539,990$

5) $800000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 90 + 5 = 800,695$

6) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 80000 + 900 + 40 + 3 = 880,943$

7) $900000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 2000 + 700 + 1 = 952,701$

8) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 50000 + 2000 + 800 + 7 = 352,807$

9) $800000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 600 + 20 = 890,620$

10) $500000 + 40000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 70 + 9 = 540,979$

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
