

Find the missing place value from a 6-digit number

Grade 5 Addition Worksheet

Example: $262,377 = 200,000 + 60,000 + 2,000 + 300 + 70 + 7$

Find the missing numbers:

1) $900000 + 90000 + 9000 + 80 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 999,088$

2) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 700 + 50 + 5 = 300,755$

3) $900000 + 90000 + 700 + 60 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 990,769$

4) $300000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 4000 + 30 = 354,030$

5) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 80000 + 1000 + 40 + 9 = 481,049$

6) $100000 + 200 + 10 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 100,213$

7) $600000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 1000 + 500 + 20 = 621,520$

8) $700000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 600 + 9 = 702,609$

9) $600000 + 90000 + 1000 + 600 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 691,660$

10) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 40000 + 800 + 8 = 340,808$

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
