

Find the missing place value from a 6-digit number

Grade 5 Addition Worksheet

Example: $125,181 = 100,000 + 20,000 + 5,000 + 100 + 80 + 1$

Find the missing numbers:

1) $500000 + 40000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 700 = 544,700$

2) $700000 + 3000 + 100 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 6 = 703,196$

3) $900000 + 20000 + 600 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 1 = 920,611$

4) $900000 + 70000 + 30 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 970,035$

5) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 60000 + 4000 + 200 = 664,200$

6) $100000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 100 + 40 = 103,140$

7) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 40000 + 4000 + 400 + 60 = 844,460$

8) $800000 + 6000 + 200 + 50 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 806,259$

9) $900000 + 70000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 100 = 971,100$

10) $900000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 700 + 80 + 9 = 920,789$

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
